

CHAIN OF CUSTODY POLICY

Allied Natural Wood Enterprises (ANWE) has implemented and maintains a Chain of Custody (CoC) Management System in accordance with the requirements of the standards that it is certified to:

ANWE is committed to trade only in forest products that are sourced from forests that are certified to the relevant forest certification standards or from forests that are well-managed and controlled, where ecological, sustainable, social and responsible forest management values are observed. All forest product inputs will undergo a due diligence test to establish legality and the risk of originating from controversial sources.

The Company publicly commits to the values embodied within the Chain of Custody Standards and it will not to be directly or indirectly involved with any of the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products;
- Violation of traditional rights and human rights in any forestry operations;
- Destruction of high conservation values through any forestry operations;
- Significant conversion of native forest to plantations or non-forest uses;
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms in any forestry operations;
- Violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions as defined in the ILO Declaration on fundamental principles and rights at work.

ANWE will act to promote its social responsibility by:

- Respecting the right for personnel to collectively bargain consistent with the ILO conventions;
- Promoting equal opportunities and treatment for all employees;
- Adhering to the minimum age of employment;
- Implementing a work health and safety system that will provide a safe and healthy workplace for all employees.

ANWE ensures continual improvement of the system, its objectives and policies to support changing resource and market demands, modern practices and technological improvements.
